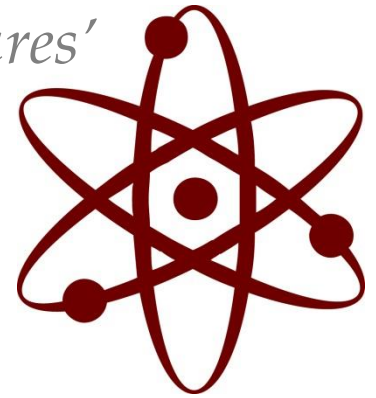

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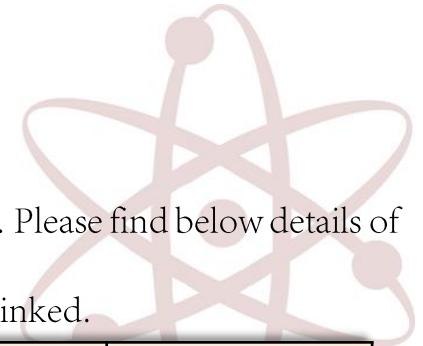
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# Enrichment Programmes & Extra Curricular Activities **2016-2017**

# Here at Marlborough...



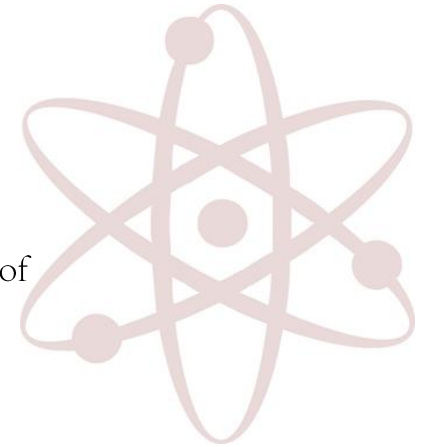
We offer our students a range of extra-curricular activities and enrichment programmes. Please find below details of clubs that take place at Marlborough.

Various **ACES Day events** are also planned for our **Gifted & Talented students**.

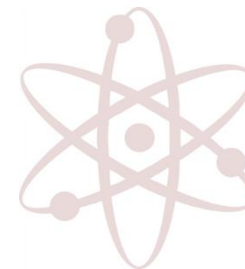
