The guidance uses the phrase 'gifted and talented' to describe all learners with gifts and talents"

Implementation

- The school will continue to provide a balanced curriculum for our ACES

- Every Faculty will be required to identify and track our ACES
- The school will create and maintain an ACES register that is regularly monitored and up dated
- Enrichment and enhancement activities will be provided by the school specifically for the ACES
- There will be an opportunity for students to take extension work to enable them to achieve higher grades and/or to support acceleration such that students can take examinations early
- The ACES Co-ordinator will monitor and evaluate all specific ACES activities
- ACES will be encouraged to participate in leisure pursuits
- The school will encourage and support the ACES to work in their specific areas
