Cropping

Cropping is a tool used by many, cropping helps cut out unwanted details along the edges of photos (like a random hand) or to just focus on a specific spot and make it larger.



Pixelated

A pixelated image is where an image is made into small squares (pixels), this can be achieved by over enlarging a picture or just by drawing in squares.



Raster image

A raster image is a picture made of pixels in a rectangular grid, each pixel holding a certain colour. However, when cropping or zooming in the raster image loses quality as it becomes blurry and pixelated.



Vector image

A vector image is made up with defined lines and curves, the places you would most likely find vector images would be in: logos, tattoos, stickers, shirt designs, and clipart.

Narrative Imagery

Narrative imagery is a moment in a film or a piece of art that tells a story. For example: From this image from the story little red riding hood, you can see naïve little red holding her basket of baked goods for her grandmother as she talks to the wolf who seems to be drooling over the thought of eating not the goods but little red. From this you can see the wolf has bad intentions that'll be made clearer in the near future.



Royalty free licencing

A royalty free licence is mainly used by stock photo agencies to sell stock photos.
