



Present Tense – ER Verbs

WHAT IS IT?

used when talking about something which is happening now or which happens in general.

There are three main types of verbs in Spanish: AR, IR and ER. An **ER verb** is just a verb (infinitive) which ends in ER.

EXAMPLES IN ENGLISH

Normally I drink water.

She eats a hamburger.

They eat potatoes.

HOW DO I FORM IT?

- 1. Choose your verb (infinitive)
- e.g. **comer** to eat
- 2. Take off the ER and add the following endings to the end of the verb depending on which person is doing the action:

ı	o	Como	l eat
You (singular)	es	Comes	You eat
He/she/it	е	Come	He/she/it eats
We	emos	Comemos	We eat
You (plural)	éis	Coméis	You eat
They	en	Comen	They eat

EXAMPLES IN SPANISH

Normalmente **bebo** agua.

Come una hamburguesa.

Comen patatas.
