



# Present Tense – AR Verbs

### WHAT IS IT?

used when talking about something which is happening now or which happens in general.

There are three main types of verbs in Spanish: AR, IR and ER. An AR verb is just a verb (infinitive) which ends in AR.

#### **EXAMPLES IN ENGLISH**

I speak Spanish.
You sing well.
He visits his friend who is called Joe.
I like dogs.

# **HOW DO I FORM IT?**

- 1. Choose your verb (infinitive)
- e.g. **hablar** to speak
- 2. Take off the AR and add the following endings to the end of the verb depending on which person is doing the action:

ı	О	Hablo	I speak
You (singular)	as	Hablas	You speak
He/she/it	а	Habla	He/she/it speaks
We	amos	Hablamos	We speak
You (plural)	ais	Hablais	You speak
They	an	Hablan	They speak
