Aims of faculty home learning:

- To reinforce threshold concepts relating to grammar, vocabulary, and phonics.
- To practice and improve the four key skills listening, speaking, reading, and writing.
- To broaden the knowledge and exposure to the target language culture.
- To promote independent learning.
- To prepare students for internal and public assessments.

Types of tasks that may be set:

- Online assignments via Pearson active learn (listening, reading, vocabulary and grammar).
- Scaffolded writing tasks.
- Translation tasks.
- Past papers.
- Vocabulary tests.
- Research cultural aspects.
- Oral preparation.

Expected time to complete home learning:

- Online active learn assignments will be set at the start of each week.
- Once a week.
