Aims of faculty home learning:

- To encourage independent learning and stimulate intellectual curiosity
- To extend class learning
- To provide scope for further development and exploration of ideas
- To provide meaningful and manageable tasks
- To prepare students for forthcoming assessments and examinations



Types of tasks that may be set:

- Short retrieval focussed tasks such as finding quotations
- Creating revision resources
- Creating quizzes for other students
- Extended writing both fiction and non-fiction
- Wider reading
- Learning spellings, vocabulary, quotations and keywords
- Research
- Reinforcement of completed class work
- Quizzes – using peer assessment/self-assessment/self-marking
- Planning/evaluation tasks
- Preparing to give a presentation
- Preparation for next lessons e.g., making notes or revision cards
- Creative responses to texts such as making, painting, building etc.
- Selecting from a homework menu

Expected time to complete home learning:

When will home learning be set?

- Weekly home learning will be set by the main class teacher.
- Where possible, home learning will be set on the same day each week.
- In some circumstances, students may also be asked to complete unfinished classwork.

How will home learning be set?

- All homework will be set on Google Classroom and/or Edulink.

Home learning will be rewarded in line with school policy

Procedures if home learning is not completed:

- Students will be given a warning and a second chance or extension to complete work.
- Should work still not be handed in students will be given a behaviour point and may be given a detention.

Who to contact should you have any concerns about home learning?

- Main class teacher who has set the home learning in the first instance
- Head of Faculty

Expected standards of presentation:

- Work should be completed in line with school presentation policy.
- Wherever possible, work should be completed online and submitted via Google Classroom.
- Work submitted on paper should be on A4 and in pen unless otherwise specified.
