RE: Year 7 Assessments

Year 7 will be taking assessments in English, Mathematics and Science between Monday 8th and Friday 19th June, these are to enable us to judge how they are progressing with their learning. The results of the assessments will also enable us to identify and address any areas where they may need additional support.

The assessments will take place in your child's normal classes as per below:

Subject	Lesson
English	A 1 hour 45 minute assessment to take place over two lessons during the assessment period, individual class teachers to confirm the lessons via Edulink.
Maths	A 1 hour assessment to take place during the assessment period, individual class teachers to confirm the lesson via Edulink.
Science	Wednesday 17 th June, Lesson 2 (7y/ScS) Wednesday 17 th June, Lesson 3 (7y/ScF and K) Thursday 18 th June, Lesson 3 (x classes and 7y/ScP)

Students will need to bring in their usual equipment for the assessments including a working calculator for the mathematics assessment. Over the coming weeks your child's teachers will prepare them for the assessments and ensure that they know what they need to revise for these.

Results will be reported to you on the Summer grade card and they will be shared with students as they become available.

If there are any concerns regarding the assessments, please contact your child's subject teacher in the first instance and as always, I am happy to help.
