Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Stratford Regeneration Fieldwork Trip – Wednesday 11th March 2026

As part of the Geography GCSE course, students are required to conduct two days of fieldwork. The first of these trips will run on Monday 11th March. The focus of the day will be human Geography and the study of regeneration in Stratford in East London, it will enable students to collect and analyse data for their Unit 3 exam.

Students must attend the two fieldwork days during the course in order to learn data collection skills and to allow them to develop knowledge of key case studies. If they do not attend, they will be required to conduct the fieldwork and data collection **in their own time**. This will also be a memorable experience for the students as they will see all the elements of the regeneration that they have studied in class.

The trip will be on Wednesday 11th March, departing school at 8.40am and arriving back at 3.15pm by coach. All students will need to bring a packed lunch for the day. Students may also bring with them a small amount of money if they wish to buy a snack from any of the outlets in the area, students will be responsible for their own money. Students may wear casual, comfortable clothing and should wear comfortable footwear such as trainers suitable for walking as we will be covering a significant distance throughout the day.

The cost for the trip is £13.50 which covers coach travel to and from the Olympic Park. **Payment will need to be made online using School Gateway (see details attached) by Friday 20th February. If your child receives free school meals, funding is available, please contact Mrs Sen on 01727 731341.**
