Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Year 11 Prom – Thursday 2nd July 2026

Preparations for the Year 11 Prom are underway and we are delighted that the event will be held on Thursday 2nd July 2026 at Hunton Park Hotel. It will start at 7.00pm and will finish at 11.00pm. The cost of a ticket will be: £58.00. The cost includes a BBQ, assorted cake selection, a welcome drink, a 360-photo pod and of course a disco. To help with our planning, we are collecting a £33.00 non-refundable deposit for the ticket.

Payments will open on School Gateway from Monday 1st December 2025. The non-refundable deposit must be paid by Friday 27th February 2026. The deposit will be deducted from the final price. The remaining balance must be paid in full by Thursday 8th May 2026.

Experience tells us that this is a fabulous evening however poor student behaviour in the upcoming months may compromise their invitation to attend the Prom.

Smoking/vaping and the consumption of alcohol at the Prom will not be permitted. Any student who appears to be under the influence of these or any other substances will be asked to leave.

We know that this will be an exciting night, one not to be missed and a night the students will remember forever. I hope as many Year 11 students as possible will be able to attend and celebrate their time here at Marlborough.
