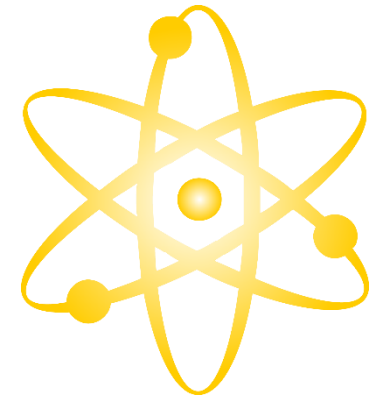

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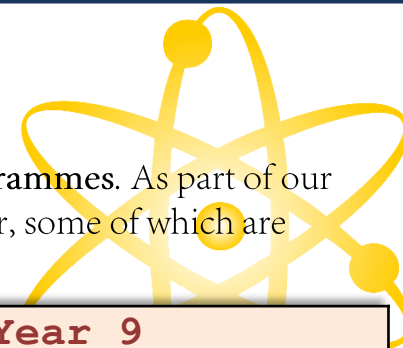

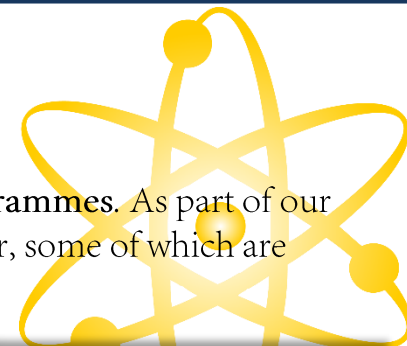
We also hold a two day Insight into **Industry Conference** for Year 9 students, where employers from many local and national companies introduce our students to the expectations and requirements of the world of employment.
