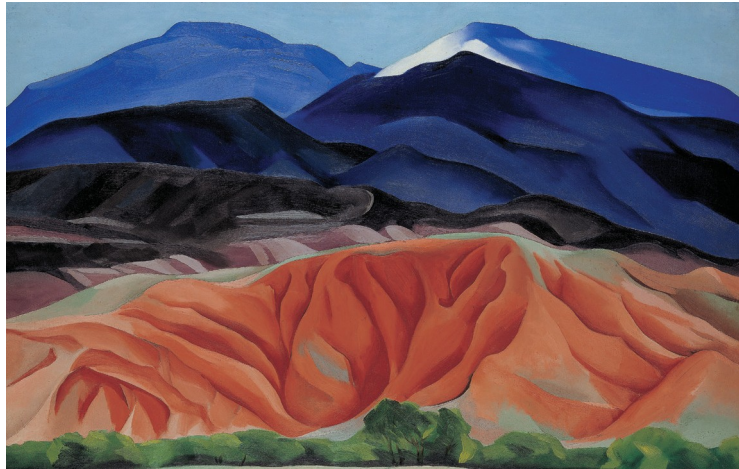


## COLOR

“I found I could say things with color and shapes that I couldn’t say any other way—things I had no words for.”

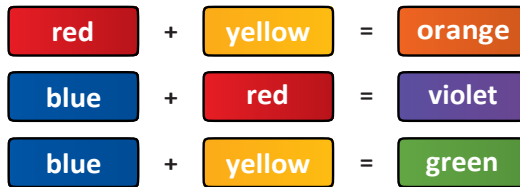

The **primary colors** are:



**Secondary colors** are made by mixing together two primary colors:



Colors convey **meanings**—for example, there are both warm colors and cool colors:



red  
yellow  
orange

blue  
violet  
green
